

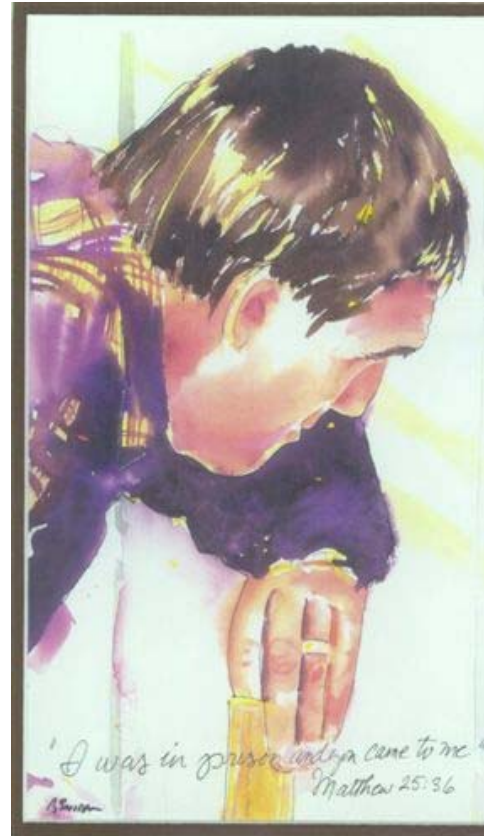

Our program officially began on September 10, 1988 under the direction of Chaplain Harold Ellis and 8 volunteers. J.A.I.L. Ministry, Inc. was incorporated as a non-profit ministry when 501c3 documents were filed on February 21, 1992. As a non-profit Christian ministry, we depend on partnerships from the business community, churches, and individuals.

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BELL COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT CENTER

Services at BCLEC: Individual Bible studies, church services, and one-on-one encouragement held inside the BCLEC and/or Juvenile Justice Center. Inmates attend on a voluntary basis. **2,732**

Professions of Faith: Those who have indicated by prayer or decision card that they have trusted Jesus Christ as their personal Savior and Lord. (John 14:6) **389**

Rededications: Those who have indicated verbally or by decision card that they have in the past trusted Jesus Christ as their personal Savior and are rededicating their lives to Him..... **1,749**

Baptisms: Those who have prayed to trust Jesus Christ as their personal Savior and have been baptized (immersed) in the J.A.I.L. Ministry Baptismal; a horse trough located in the recreation area of the BCLEC, and/or on the roof of the Bell County Central Jail **36**

Volunteer Visits: Approved J.A.I.L. Ministry Volunteers who teach a Bible study, Saturday Church, and/or provide one-on-one encouragement. **4,017**

Bible Study/Church Attendance: Individuals who have attended a J.A.I.L. Ministry staff and/or volunteer-led Bible study or church service one or more times in the BCLEC or Juvenile Justice Center. **13,586**

Individual Contacts: One or more contacts to inmates made by J.A.I.L. Ministry staff and/or volunteers inside the BCLEC and the Bell County Central Jail. **257**

Write-Way & Crossroads Bible Correspondence: The J.A.I.L. Ministry registers BCLEC inmates, at their request, for ongoing Bible correspondence courses in the BCLEC. Inmates receive certificates for each course they complete. Over 60 courses are available and may be continued in State Jail, Texas Department of Corrections, or wherever the inmate may go. **232**

Bibles Distributed: J.A.I.L. Ministry provides Bibles, at no charge, to inmates. The Free on The Inside Bible is a New King James Version with helps especially written for the incarcerated. **1,564**

Christian Books Distributed: A list of Christian books and publications is available and inmates may choose one per week at no charge. Books and publications are both purchased by and donated to J.A.I.L. Ministry. **1,746**

Eye Glasses Distributed **330**

Prayer Requests: Prayer requests are received from inmates, their families, and friends. Inmates requests are received by prayer decision cards. Other requests are received by the J.A.I.L. Ministry via mail, phone, internet, and the BCLEC website link. Prayer requests are sent out weekly to be prayed by J.A.I.L. Ministry prayer partners. **5,360**

Project Angel Tree: Affiliated with Prison Fellowship, J.A.I.L. Ministry participates in this program where volunteers present 3 Christmas gifts to each inmates child. Children may live locally, out of town, or out of state. J.A.I.L. Ministry also serves the children of BCLEC Correctional Officers and Deputies..... **1,122**

Anger Resolution: Inmates who have completed a 9 hour or longer court approved course provided by J.A.I.L. Ministry. Upon completion of a course, a certificate is awarded that is honored by the courts. Director of Men's Ministry, Johner Martin, and Juvenile Services Coordinator, Cheryl Baird, are the Bell County Approved Anger Resolution Instructors for J.A.I.L. Ministry. **446**

Men's Life Skills Class: Men inmates volunteer to attend The Quest for Authentic Manhood; a multi-media study utilizing the Quest DVD lecture series, workbook, and group discussion. **682**

Women's Life Skills Class: Women inmates volunteer to attend Breaking Free, a Beth Moore study using multi-media DVD training, worksheets, and group discussion. **335**

The J.A.I.L. Ministry Radio Network: Broadcasts are 24 hours a day, 7 days a week inside the BCLEC on low-power FM., and on-line at www.jailmin.org. Inmates can purchase personal radios at the BCLEC Commissary. **738**

Decision Cards: Cards provided to inmates giving them choices for making decisions; as in Profession of Faith; Rededication; etc..... **8,300**
