Anger Resolution: Inmates who have completed a 9 hour or longer court approved course provided by J.A.I.L. Ministry. Upon completion of a course, a certificate is awarded that is honored by the courts. Director of Men's Ministry, Johner Martin, and Juvenile Services Coordinator, Cheryl Baird, are the Bell County Approved Anger Resolution Instructors for J.A.I.L. Ministry.
